Well, summer is over and fall has just come upon us, but that doesn't mean it's too late to "hit for the cycle." I, as an Atlanta Braves fan, have been following the team especially closely lately, and I've been watching the stats:

- Matt Olson, who plays first base, has 53 home runs so far this season, which broke a record previously held by Andruw Jones (with 51 home runs) for the franchise. He also currently has the record for most home runs in the entire league. Furthermore, Olson has the most RBIs (that's "runs batted in," in case you're not a baseball fan). He has **ELEVATED** his single-season career beyond all expectations.
- Ronald Acuna Jr., right-fielder for Atlanta, also holds two records currently: the most hits with 213 and the most stolen bases with 70, MLB-wide. He is **ACTIVATING** the minds of young baseball hopefuls all over the world with his abilities, both in the field and at the plate.
- Spencer Strider, perhaps the best starting pitcher for not just Atlanta, but MLB-wide, currently holds the record for most wins and most strike -outs. He is **EDUCATING** other pitchers at how it works in your favor when you go out, try your best, and put everything you have into the game.
- The Atlanta Braves as a whole, are "hitting for the cycle." They currently have the most wins of any team in the MLB with 102 wins, and the year isn't over yet (this is big considering a year of baseball consists of 162 games). And, as their management **RECRUITS** to the best of their abilities, they are proving something right: they have six consecutive National League East championships including this year. Those guys are doing something right!


